

- 1. This is a Recreational Tournament. Registration will end at midnight Friday 4/26/2024. **Tournament Check-in is on Wednesday night 5/1/2024 from 5:00 to 8:00 PM at the Clovis Crossfire office located at 55 Shaw Ave, Suite 118, Clovis CA 93612 (Shaw and Minnewawa Ave).** Failure to do so may result in a forfeiture of the first game.
- 2. All teams are required to have GOLDENROD'S & signed PLAYER PASSES (as issued by the appropriate District 7 League Commissioner or Registrar), all ADD/DROP/TRANSFER and 'Guest players' forms and MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS (1601's). Each team is allowed up to (3) "guest players" with appropriate guest player documentation signed and filled out completely. Guest players must be registered in the league from which the team originates from. Guest players who hold a competitive pass will not be allowed to participate.
- 3. Each team is required to check-in at the headquarters tent **AT LEAST 30 MINUTES** prior to the scheduled start of each game for pregame check-in by the Referee/Field Monitor. **Any player not providing the proper player pass will not be allowed to participate in the game**.
- 4. The HOME TEAM is required to change jerseys in case of a COLOR CONFLICT. Due to space limitations, both teams will be on narrow side of fields, spectators will be on opposite side of field. Only passed players and coaches will be allowed in team area. For all Semi-final, Championship and Consolation games the team with the highest points going into the match will be HOME TEAM.
- 5. **GAME CARDS**: Will be provided by the tournament.
- 6. **(3) GAME BALLS**: Will be provided by the HOME Team.
- 7. Tournament rules take priority in all tournament affairs. Areas not covered by Tournament rules, are covered by CYSA rules and FIFA/IFAB rules as modified by Cal North.
- 8. **ALL GAMES ARE FINAL** as determined by the game Referee. **NO PROTESTS ARE ALLOWED**. Any complaints or questions that cannot be answered at the field site shall be directed to the Tournament Director and **NOT** to the game Referee.
- 9. LENGTH OF GAMES.

<u>U8</u>: 4x4 format (2) 20-minute halves, no overtime. **NO GOALKEEPER AT THIS AGE!** Overtime: Golden Goal Rule will determine winner in semifinals & finals only.

<u>U10</u>: 7v7 format, (2) 20-minute halves, no overtime.

Overtime: (2) 5-minute halves followed by PK's in semifinals & finals only.

U12: 9v9 format, (2) 25-minute halves, no overtime.

Overtime: (2) 5-minute halves followed by PK's in semifinals & finals only.

U14-U19: 11v11 format, (2) 30-minute halves.

Overtime: (2) 5-minute halves followed by PK's in semifinals & finals only.

10. POINTS FOR PRELIMINARY GAMES:

Win: 6 points Tie: 3 points Loss: 0 points

Shutout: 1 point in addition to the 'win'

Goals: 1 point (maximum of 3 points per game) **Forfeit**: 9 points to opposite team (posted a 2-0 win)

Mercy rule: 1 point deducted for every goal scored beyond +7 goal differential with a

maximum of a 3-point deduction.

Red Card: 1 point deduction for each red card

No points will be awarded if neither team shows for a game. The maximum number of points a team can earn in any one game is 10. Official standings shall be kept at Tournament Headquarters. Unofficial results will be posted at other fields. Play may be suspended once the score reaches a 10-goal differential, at the referee discretion.

11. TIE BREAKERS are as follows:

- A. Winner of Head-to-Head play
- B. Goal Differential
- C. Fewest Goals Allowed
- D. Most Goals Scored
- E. Fewest Number of Red Cards
- F. "Penalty Shootout"
- 12. **SUBSTITUTIONS** are considered 'free substitution' in all age groups provided team is in possession of the ball (throw-in). If team with possession subs both teams may substitute. Both teams may substitute during a dead ball situation (goal kicks, goal scored, or injury).
- 13. **FORFEITS** occur when a team does not field the minimum number of players within 5 minutes of the scheduled game time.

14. NO ORTHOPEDIC DEVICES OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED

15. NO NOISE MAKING DEVICES ALLOWED

16. **AWARDS**:

A. Individual awards for 1st and 2nd places in all brackets.

B. A team Trophy will be awarded to tournament winners.

Trophies will be distributed on-site, immediately following the

Championship game.
